Just a Couple of Reminders:

We are in Hurricane Season and for the safety of all our residents and guests, we want to make sure that everyone knows what, where, and how to survive if we receive Hurricane, Tornado, or Severe Storm Warnings and Watches.

Here are some of the **Whats:**

First, be sure to have the Campers App downloaded on your smart phone, this is where we can communicate all necessary information to you. **Second**, be sure to have a backpack ready with Emergency Supplies such as medications, bottled water, cash, non-perishable foods, cell phone charger, and personal hygiene items. It could be 2-3 days before assistance is available.

Third, have a sufficient supply of batteries, flashlights, bottled water, canned foods, and medications on hand.

Where: Tornado: The County does NOT have a shelter in place for **Tornado** warnings and watches. The safest place within Sunshine Village is inside the public bathrooms & club house (away from the windows). Although our structures are NOT Tornado Certified, they are safer than your RV or Mobile Home. Sumter County DOES have Shelters for **Hurricane** Warnings and Watches. The Sumter Co. Fairgrounds is pet friendly and is less than 2 miles away. They also have cots available to sleep on. Secondary location is Webster Elementary School (Handicap accessible).
