Lot Change Requests: Please remember that, while we encourage beautification and upgrades to your lot and home, **ALL** proposed changes **must be** in writing and preapproved.

This includes any and all changes to your home site. Please call (518-744-8419) or see Al Huestis, Project Manager (MH12) **BEFORE** beginning **ANY** project.

Reminder: If you have overnight guest(s) staying with you, they must be registered on the clipboard outside the office. This is required by the health department for emergency purposes. You may have guests stay with you for two consecutive weeks

at no charge, after the first two weeks, the \$5/per day fee applies.

Trash: For safety reason, when putting trash curbside by 9 a.m. on Monday and Thursday, please do not use the large garbage bags, unless they are very light. The workers will not pick up any trash that is not bagged (including lawn debris). Trash pick up curbside is a courtesy we do for you, not a requirement. Please be considerate. **PLEASE, No Furniture, No Appliances, No Construction Debris, ONLY Daily Household Trash is to be placed in the Dumpsters. If you have other than Household Trash, PLEASE call the office at 352-793-8626 and leave a message, we will get back to you and advise you what to do with your items. Please do not place ANYTHING outside of dumpsters.**

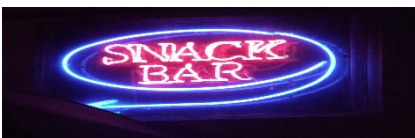
Community Pancake Breakfast
