### Reminders

#### A few reminders of our policies

**Trash:** Curbside pick up is on Monday and Thursday (excluding holidays). Please have your bagged household trash only curbside by 9:00 (NOT the night before). Pick up will be on Monday & Friday Thanksgiving week.

**Yard Debris:** Yard debris can be taken (UNBAGGED) to the Red Utility Trailer located inside of the South Side Super Site Entrance.

**Site Changes:** ALL site changes (including landscaping) MUST be requested in writing BEFORE you begin ANY Projects. (Forms available at the office).

**Pets:** ALL pets MUST be leashed and under your control at ALL times. You may NOT tie out your pet unless you will be outside with them. Temporary RVers ONLY, may use outdoor gates/pens but must be outside with the pets. **Clean up after your pet immediately.** There are poop stations throughout the resort. Tie waste bags shut and dispose of properly, Outdoor resepticles ONLY. NO pets are allowed in ANY of our buildings or laundry areas.

**Other Lots:** Please **do not walk or cut across ANYONE'S lot** when going to the dumpster, pool, or anywhere else.

**Proper Attire:** We want you to enjoy the pool and Tiki Hut areas, but please remember that before entering the Sunshine Hall that you are NOT bare footed, men must put a shirt on and ladies must wear a swimsuit cover up. Some may enjoy going barefoot and men going shirtless, that is fine on YOUR OWN SITE ONLY.

**Golf Carts:** You MUST BE at least 16 years of age to operate a golf cart anywhere on Sunshine Village property.
