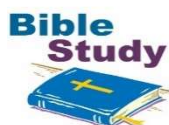
Horse Racing Returns

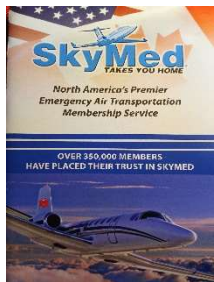
