Each Item will have a **"Mystery Price"** (that NO ONE sees) attached to the bottom of it.

**Bidding Starts (by Raising Your Numbered Bidding Paddle) at 25 Cents, and Increase at a rate of 25 Cents EACH.**

**Every time you bid, you will pay only 25 Cents.**

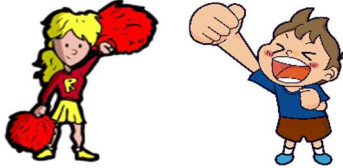
