## Sunshine Gold Club Card Program

**Trash Pickup:** Pickup is curbside on Mondays and Thursdays at 9:00 am. Please do not put your trash out the night before. **Only household trash will be collected** and **ALL trash needs to be bagged**. No totes, trash cans, or loose items.

Cardboard needs to be flattened down. If you put ANYTHING other than household trash in the dumpsters, you WILL be billed a minimum fee of \$25.00. You MUST see Jim Geers, Maintenance Dept. on where to take all other debris.

**Walking:** When walking from one area to another within the resort kindly remember that you are NOT permitted to “cut across” ANY of the MH or RV sites (whether the people are home or not). Please stay on the paved roadways and off any sites that are not yours.

**Pets:** PLEASE, be responsible and clean up any dog poo immediately. There are bags and disposal containers throughout the property and in the dog park area.

**Tiki Hut & Sunset Park Pavilion:** The tiki hut & Pavilion are for your use and enjoyment. If you use the grill, **YOU CLEAN the grill** and make certain you turn the LP tanks off when you are finished grilling. Please do NOT leave ANYTHING in either of the refrigerators. Please take any trash you may have to the dumpster when you are finished, it will help prevent ants, flies, wildlife and other strays from getting into it.

**Parking:** Residents may NOT park their vehicles in any of the “over flow” parking lots. These are reserved for Guests and Sunrise Hall functions.
