Feeding the Animals: There is a total restriction on feeding ANY animals, fish, turtles, or birds inside Sunshine Village Resort. Please do not put out ANY source of food.

Respect their Space: Your lot is the ONLY lot you or your pets should be walking across. Please do not cut or walk through, behind, or on anyone else's lot or site for any reason.

Trash: ALL trash MUST be **BAGGED**, even lawn debris, or it will NOT be picked up. Scheduled days for trash pick-up are Monday & Thursday at 9:00 am. The dumpsters are now located behind the pool area and will be locked each night and unlocked each morning to prevent illegal dumping of trash after dark. **(No Electronics, Furniture or Construction Debris is to be put into the dumpsters.)**

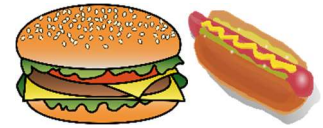
