**your smartphone or tablet. The**

**App is how we communicate.**

**Emergency Weather Updates!**

**A “watch” means that conditions**

**are favorable for a severe**

**weather event. A “warning”**

**means that there IS severe**

**weather in our immediate area.**

**What You NEED to KNOW**

**When we receive notification of a severe**

**weather event in our area, we will put an**

**ALERT on the CampsApp. A vehicle will**

**drive throughout Sunshine Village Resort**

**(RV Supersites First) with Lights and**

**Flashers on. You will hear 4-Short Horn**

**Blows, Silence, 4-Short Horn Blows,**

**Silence. This will be repeated throughout**

**the property until it is now longer safe to**

**do so.**

**You should IMMEDIATELY seek shelter**

**either in one of the Bathroom/Shower**

**areas or at Sunrise Hall.**

**Although none of our buildings are**

**Tornado or Hurricane rated, the county**

**EMS and Emergency Management have**

**deemed these locations SAFER than an**

**RV or Mobile Home. Pets must be**

**leashed or crated, but are allowed inside**

**buildings during emergencies ONLY.**

**Tornadoes:** There are NO shelters set up

**for tornadoes, there is not enough time**

**and we are on our own. Please listen for**

**App Alerts and our Safety Warning**

**Teams and follow the protocols we have**

**Hurricanes:** Usually the county has ample time to set up and open the local evacuation centers in case of a Hurricane. Sumter County has 2 locations in our area.

**Webster Elementary School on SR471,** just south of Family Dollar. This shelter is handicap accessible, and the other shelter is Sumter County Fairgrounds on SR471 North of the City of Webster.

**BE STORM READY:** Everyone should have an Emergency Backpack READY at the DOOR! Items should include:

3-days of medications, Emergency Contacts w/ phone numbers, Bottled Water, Phone Chargers, CASH (ATM machines will not be operating), A Flashlight & Batteries, Personal Wipes, Hand Sanitizer, Personal Hygiene Products, Canned Foods w/ Pull tab lids (ready to eat). Food and Dishes for your pets. It is also a good idea to have copies of your insurance policies, driver’s license, medication & allergy lists. Have a plan, know your plan, and STAY SAFE!
