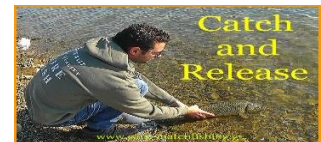

**New Trash Program:** In our Continuing efforts to maintain a clean and pleasant resort, it has been decided that the trash dumpsters will now be relocated inside the storage area at the supersites. Dumpsters will be locked and non-accessible. Household trash collection will now be done daily. You **MUST** have your household trash placed curbside no later than 9:00 am. **Nothing will be collected after 10:00 am.** Do NOT leave trash setting out overnight. Lawn debris and trimmings will be collected on **MONDAYS ONLY.** All leaves must be bagged, branches and limbs must be cut and stacked. If you have larger items or non-household garbage to dispose of, you may drop them off at the citizen's drop off at 819 CR 529, Lake Panasoffkee, or call the office to arrange for them to be collected. Remember there is a charge for disposal of larger items.
