Reminders: In order to keep Sunshine Village Resort a beautiful and pleasant place to live, we have Rules & Regulations that we all must adhere to.

Dog Poo: We are all tired of seeing this reminder, however, there is still an issue with residents not cleaning up after their pets. The Swales, Dog Park, and around the Pond are **NOT** exception areas. You **MUST** clean up after your pets **anywhere within Sunshine Village Resort.**

Trash: Daily household trash pick up is at 10:00 each day. All trash must be bagged and cardboard flattened. Please do not set **ANY** trash out curbside the night before or after 10:00am. If you have large items such as electronics, furniture, or other "non-household" trash items, you must contact the office or the maintenance department to find out if the item will be removed, and what the cost will be.

Parking: **Golf carts** are permitted to park in the designated Golf Cart Parking areas at the North and West sides of Sunrise Hall, not in front of the Hall. (our ambassadors will park in the striped area when on duty). **Cars & Trucks:** No one should be parking IN, or on the side of the streets. Visitor parking is located by the Pickleball Court and at the West End of Sunrise Hall. If you have visitors and their vehicle will not fit in your driveway, they must utilize the visitor parking areas.
