Important Reminders: ALL homes and RV's **MUST** be power washed before you leave, if they are not clean, we will hire someone to do the work, and your account will be billed for the services. If you are a year-round resident, it is time to look over your home and have it cleaned if it is time. If you cannot do the work yourself, there are a few residents here that do that work, and would appreciate your business.

Trash: Daily trash pickup is done at **10:00am every day (excluding holidays)**. You **MUST** have your **bagged** household trash and **flattened cardboard** curbside no later than 10:00am. You are **NOT** permitted to set **ANYTHING out the night before, or after 10:00am.**

During our nightly safety checks throughout the resort, we are finding several sites with cardboard and trash set out at night. Our TEAM has been asked to notify the office of any violations of this rule. We take pride in our appearance, and we do not want any wildlife critters to dine during the night. If you have large household items to dispose of, you MUST check with maintenance, and they will give you a price for the removal of your items. Furniture, carpets, construction debris, electronics, or any other large items may NOT be set curbside unless pre-arranged by maintenance.

Storm Season is upon us. Florida weather is unpredictable, dangerous, and sometimes hits without warning. **Be Storm Ready:** Most importantly, **make sure you download the Campersapp onto your smartphone or tablet.** This is the system we use to keep our residents informed of important updates, warnings, watches, and changes in schedules, emergency repairs, and other possible life-threatening announcements. You **MUST** have **everything outside** ready to move indoors or properly secured so it cannot become a projectile during severe thunderstorms, high winds, tornados, or hurricanes. Any damage caused to your neighbors or Sunshine Village Resort property by your items not being secured will be your financial responsibility. We strongly encourage you to retract your RV awnings before leaving for any length of time. Storms hit quickly and may punch high winds, hail, and torrential rain fall. There have been several awnings damaged here in the past; don't let it be yours. Although our buildings are not tornado or hurricane rated, the Sumter County Emergency Management and Fire Departments have deemed them MUCH safer than being in an RV during strong storms. Our safety team will drive through all the RV areas with lights on, flashers on, blowing the horn 4 quick beeps, then a few seconds of quiet, repeating this sequence as a warning to you to move to a better shelter. Either comfort station shower stalls, or Sunrise Hall are safer areas. Pets must be leashed or crated to go to a safe area with you. Finally, be sure to have an emergency backpack ready. It should have 3-days medications, all important documents, Identification, ready to eat canned foods and snacks (can opener), cell phone chargers and some cash.

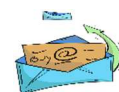
